#### **Can I live at Woodbrook?** **Clinical Eligibility**

A person must meet the following clinical criteria to be eligible for assisted living:

- Safe in their own room
- Medically stable
- Ambulatory or independent in wheelchair mobility
- Continent or manages incontinence
- Has a mentally healthy frame of mind so as not to be a danger to themselves or others
- If on oxygen or insulin, must be able to manage independently

#### **Financial Eligibility**

- Assisted living is not covered by Medicare or Medicaid.
- With a variety of ten room options, we have ten different room costs.
- Room rates are higher for larger rooms.
- Assisted living is more affordable than most people think. See other side for a comparison study of the benefits of assisted living versus costly responsibilities of living at home.

#### **What does Woodbrook offer?**

- 24-hour assistance and supervision by a qualified, experienced staff
- Personal care assistance
- Case management services including coordination of health care needs and communication between resident, family and physician
- Three meals a day
- Assistance with medication administration
- Housekeeping
- Laundry
- Daily activities and programs focusing on physical, cognitive, social and spiritual needs
- Transportation to medical appointments

#### **What if I need more assistance later on?**

- Woodbrook can help assist in placement of a resident at a skilled nursing facility (SNF) if appropriate.
- Woodbrook can help facilitate End of Life Hospice care for residents who choose to stay at our facility and are clinically eligible.
